WEBSYDIAN AND ADVANTAGE PLEX v5.1 LOCAL MODEL LICENSING

The Advantage Plex v5.1 have been released and adds valuable new features to the Plex community. One of these new features is local model licensing, which enables the licensing system to validate the license upon opening the local model instead of validating license at group model login. Upgrading your existing Websyidian patterns to Plex 5.1 requires that you install a file in the Websyidian group model directory. Please visit "known problems" at our support site for further information about this issue.

WEBSYDIAN v3.1 FIXES FOR DWA ISERIES

Unfortunately an error has been found in the runtime objects of DWA for iSeries which resulted in a memory leak. Further information and the updated objects which solve this problem can be found at our support site.

WEBSYDIAN v3.1a INTRODUCING THE WEBSHOP PATTERN

The Websyidian v3.1a is available, adding a new WebShop pattern. The WebShop pattern replaces the WsyCart pattern and is fundamentally different from the WsyCart pattern, which is the reason that you are not able to upgrade applications from WsyCart pattern to the WebShop pattern. Further information on the WebShop pattern can be found at our web site and documentation site. Please note that the WebShop pattern requires license to the BStructure and BUtil patterns from CA.
