HIGH SEVERITY MEMORY LEAK IN WEBSYDIAN TRANSACXML FOR WINDOWS FIXED

An error has been identified in the Websyidian TransacXML for Windows that affects the overall stability of programs developed using Websyidian TransacXML for Windows. The error is corrected in the next release of Websyidian.

The error is associated with the function *TerminateDom* and will cause a memory leak. For further information on the problem and a workaround for existing applications please read the document:

INSERTION OF TYPE *COMPLEX ELEMENTS* IN WEBSYDIAN TRANSACXML FIXED

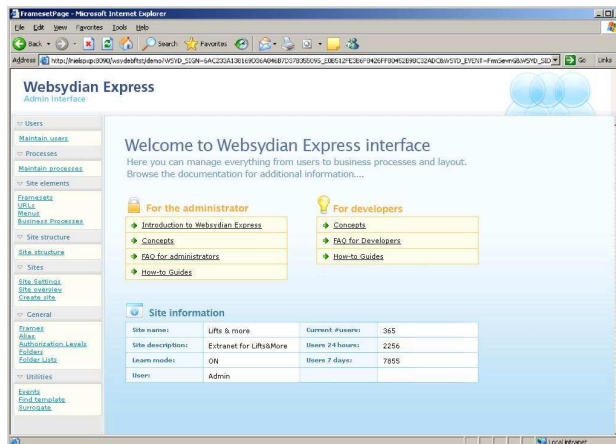
