HIGH SEVERITY MEMORY LEAK IN WEBSYDIAN TRANSACXML FOR WINDOWS FIXED

An error has been identified in the Websydian TransacXML for Windows that affects the overall stability of programs developed using Websydian TransacXML for Windows. The error is corrected in the next release of Websydian.
