



## **Technical Bulletin – Issue #8**

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Welcome to the eighth issue of the Websyidian technical bulletin. The technical bulletins contain important technical information from the Websyidian Development Team. In this bulletin there are four topics as follows:

### **COMING RELEASE “EMBLA” WILL UPGRADE WEBSYDIAN ISERIES RUNTIME TO V5R1**

With the next version of Websyidian code name “Embla” the Websyidian iSeries runtime objects will be upgraded to OS/400 V5R1. Please note that Websyidian follows the support plan for OS/400 as described by IBM. For further information about supported Websyidian and Plex versions please read the Support Life Span document available at the Websyidian website in the Support area.

### **IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SERVLET RELAY SERVICE FOR WEBSYDIAN DWA v4.0 AND v5.5**

A number of improvements have been made to the *Servlet Relay Service* for Websyidian v4.0 and v5.5. The changes primarily target the servlet initialization procedure making the *Servlet Relay Service* tolerant to errors occurring during this phase. This removes the requirements to reload the *Servlet Relay Service* if an error occurs during the servlet initialization procedure. The updated `wsyddwa20.jar` file is available for download in the latest fix package from our website.

### **LICENSING PROBLEMS USING WEBSYDIAN v5.5**

During packing of the Websyidian v5.5 library models an error occurred and the supplied `gmi.dat` files were not correctly updated. This results in Plex requesting licensing keys for Websyidian v4.0 though it should request keys for Websyidian v5.5. At our website please download the new `gmi.dat` files for WSYBASE and WSYDOM. ### **SUPPORT FOR WEBSYDIAN v3.1 RETIRES ON THE 1<sup>ST</sup> OF MARCH 2005**

As mentioned in Technical Bulletin issue #5 the support for Websyidian v3.1 will discontinue on the 1<sup>st</sup> of March 2005. We strongly encourage our customers to upgrade to the latest version of Websyidian in order to be able to get support, and take advantage of new features.
