### WSDL/Scheme import beta release

Websydian WSDL/Schema Import is currently available in a beta version for testing and feedback from you before final release.

Currently only the schema import part is supported in the beta release, WSDL import is in the process of design.

## Improved runtime for Websydian Server

We have improved the runtime of the Websydian Server significantly.

#### WebsydianExpress v2.1

A service release for WebsydianExpress is now available.

This service release includes among other things the following:

- 1. Improved performance of load site structure by use of a lazy-load
- 2. Properties on Presentations. Option for configuring the Business Processes using name value pairs for input parameters. This also includes a number of new API's for Plex, 2E and RPG developer.
- 3. Fix of minor bugs introduced in WebsydianExpress v2.0
- 4. Fixed templates in the administration interface, IE 7.0 problems.

## Websydian Express v2.1 for Plex v6.0

With the service release we also release a variant for Plex v6.0. This is for the Windows versions because of the missing backward compatibility on the Plex Windows runtime

If upgrading from Plex 5.5SP1 to Plex 6.0 and using one of the Windows variants of Websydian Express, you will need to generate and build all your business processes.

A major improvement with Plex v6.0 is performance because of the changes made in Plex v6.0 on unloading DLL's.
