## Release of Websyidian v6.0

---

Websyidian v6.0 was made available this month and includes support for Plex v6.0. In order to develop Windows applications or using the new C# .Net Server variant with Plex v6.0 and Websyidian you will need to upgrade to Websyidian v6.0.

Websyidian v6.0 also includes the long anticipated feature for creating web pages that enable upload of files. Note only supported using DWA.

## Release of WebsyidianExpress v2.0

---

Also released this month is the 2.0 version of the WebsyidianExpress framework for fast and secure development of web applications using Plex/Websyidian, 2E or RPG. With this version you get a role based authorization system as well as a number of other new features and enhancements. Websyidian v6.0 will be the last major version supporting Plex v5.0 and v5.1. The next major version of Websyidian, planned for 4Q-2008/Q1-2009, will support Plex v5.5SP1 and Plex v6.0.

We would like to know your opinion on this matter, and of course urge you to upgrade to the latest version of Websyidian as well as Plex.

Until the next major release we will be providing tools for importing XML Schemas into Websyidian TransacXML, and any fixes required.

## System i Support

---

As we move on with support for i5/OS V6R1 we will discontinue the support for i5/OS V5R1 and i5/OS V5R2 with the release of the next major release of Websyidian - 4Q-2008/Q1-2009.
